

Minister's Representative – AEDARSA

The Honourable Doug Griffiths, Minister of Municipal Affairs, is seeking a new ministerial representative to serve on the Alberta Elevating Devices and Amusement Rides Safety Association (AEDARSA) Board of Directors.

The Province of Alberta has delegated the responsibility of administering specific safety services relating to elevators, escalators, dumbwaiters, freight platform lifts, man lifts, personnel hoists, lifts for persons with physical disabilities, amusement rides and passenger ropeways (ski lifts etc.) to the Alberta Elevating Devices and Amusement Rides Safety Association (AEDARSA). AEDARSA's board provides oversight and guidance to the organization as they perform their delegated duties.

Some of AEDARSA's delegated safety services include:

- conducting plans reviews, inspections and tests for acceptance of new and altered installations;
- performing accident investigations;
- maintaining and managing the annual certificates of operation system; and
- providing technical advice and education on applicable codes and standards.

Appointment: Members of the Board of Directors are appointed for two-year terms. Members can expect to spend one or two days per month on AEDARSA business.

Note: No salary is offered, but expenses are reimbursed.

Qualifications: The ideal candidate will have some knowledge of Alberta's safety system particularly relating to codes and standards affecting AEDARSA's disciplines. The candidate will also have demonstrated ability to effectively represent the interests of the Minister and act as liaison between the Minister and the Board.

The successful candidate must disclose any known or potential conflict of interest before they are appointed and must agree to abide by the Council's Code of Conduct and Ethics.
