Subject: Elevating Devices Code Update Courses

Issue: Where can I find Elevating Devices Code Update Courses?

Background:

1. Elevator Mechanic (Elevator Constructor) is a designated occupation in Alberta meaning only trained personnel can maintain elevating devices

Issued: June 1, 2021

- Safety Codes Act and the Elevating Devices Codes Regulation require that properly trained elevators mechanics carry their duties and must not perform any work they are not qualified to carry out.
- 3. It is essential that an Elevator Mechanic be knowledgeable about latest adopted regulations and codes that pertain to elevating devices they work on.
- 4. Elevator mechanic must have a copy of the latest Alberta elevating devices regulation.
- 5. Elevator Mechanic must have access, at the employer's office, to all the codes and standards that apply to the equipment that elevator mechanic is responsible for.
