Subject: Minimum number and location of Operating Personnel for Surface Lifts, Rope Tows and Rope Tows using secondary carriers.

Issue: Clarification of the requirements on the number of Operators/Attendants and their location.

Background: A recent SERIOUS incident resulted from lift operators unable to visually monitor and observe the lift operation at the unload area.

As per CSA Z98 Surface Lifts, Rope Tows and Rope Tows using secondary carriers require the following minimum number of operators and locations.

- One person will be in charge of each passenger ropeway during operation.
- One attendant will be at each loading station of each passenger ropeway during operation.
- Ropeways using secondary carriers are required to have one attendant at each station. (Load and Unload)
- Attendants shall be located were there can monitor and observe the passenger ropeway operation

Requirements: Operators/Attendants shall be located at both **Load** and **Unload** stations if the following cannot be maintained.

- Visual observation of the load and unload areas
- Visual observation of the lift line, and towing attachments
- At times when the number of riders using device may impede or distract the Operator/Attendant or restrict their view of the unload area

In addition, all load and unload areas are required to have:

- Stopping devices
- communication devices, and
- written operational and safety procedures.
